

Instructions for How to get to James Byrne Centre.

1. Travelling from Brisbane.

- a) Nearing the top of the range, move to the right hand lane at the 60klm zone. At the top of the range, take the right slip lane leading to Margaret Street and turn right at the T intersection. After approx. 100metres, the road veers left onto Margaret Street.
- b) Continue all the way down Margaret Street (a beautiful tree lined street). As you go down Margaret Street, you'll pass the well-maintained and picturesque grounds of the Grammar School on your left, and further down, on your right, Queens Park. Travel straight through the roundabout and exit the roundabout into the middle or right hand lanes before turning right towards Crows Nest at the traffic lights.
- c) After about 200 metres, veer left into Chalk Drive (both lanes are OK) immediately **before** the traffic lights. Continue straight ahead at the next set of traffic lights. At the traffic lights at the T intersection turn right onto Ruthven Street/ New England Highway/ A3. Head north on this road for approx 9 klm to the James Byrne turnoff.
- d) To indication that you are going in the right direction, some landmarks are as follows: After a few sets of traffic lights, you'll see Downlands College on the right. A little further along, the road follows the lip of range escarpment with breathtaking views of the Lockyer Valley and beyond to the right. After cresting the hill, go straight ahead at the traffic lights at the intersection of Murphys Creek Road.
- e) After about 1 klm, you'll pass Brindabella Rose Gardens on your left. Merge into the right lane as soon as you enter the school zone not far from the gardens. After a short distance, **you will note a large landscape nursery directly ahead. Look for the right turn and slip lane leading to Recreation Reserve Road and James Byrne Centre before the nursery.** Follow this road for approx 2klm, being careful of the sharp turn at the bottom of the hill. The road leads straight into the entry of James Byrne Centre.

2. Travelling from the south (Warwick etc).

Take note that parts of the city centre are one-way ring roads!

- a) After passing the Cambooya Connection turnoff on your left, travel about 4klm and turn right (follow the New England Highway) to Toowoomba. Staying on this road will take you through the city business centre (Ruthven Street) and beyond to meet up with location **1.c) as above** (Ruthven Street and Chalk Drive). Take note of lane directional arrows when nearing the city centre.
- b) Alternatively, follow directional signage to Brisbane until James Street. Stay on Ruthven Street/ New England Highway/ A3 and turn right at James Street traffic lights. Get into the left hand lane and continue straight through the next set of traffic lights, and turn left at the following set (Hume Street). After travelling straight ahead through three sets of traffic lights turn left into Chalk Drive as per **1c) above**.

3. Travelling from the north.

The turnoff to James Byrne Centre is approximately 33klm south of Crows Nest. Having passed the Shell and BP service stations on the highway at Highfields, go straight ahead at the next traffic lights. About 1.5klm after the traffic lights, large signs indicate the turnoff to James Byrne Centre and Recreation Reserve Road immediately after passing the produce and landscape center on the left. **See 1e) above.**

4. Travelling from the west (Dalby etc).

After passing through Charlton, continue straight ahead and past the airport on Bridge Street. Go under the subway just after Mort Street, over the railway crossing and then turn left onto Ruthven Street. Head north for approx 8 klm. to the turnoff **See 1d) above.**
