

## 2013 AAR NATIONAL RALLY

The AAR National Rally for 2013 is planned to be held at Sutton NSW, with the Rally HQ operating from the Capital Country Holiday Park Village, 47 Bidges St Sutton NSW. The proposed dates for the rally are 8 – 11 March 2013. These dates have no clashes with any States/Territories school holidays and will enable those travelling to the Tassie Tour 2013 to attend the AAR rally and then travel to the apple isle.

- Friday 8 Mar 13. Rally registration opens from noon Friday at the Camp Kitchen. A short fettling run will be held on Friday 8 Mar 13, leaving about 2:30 PM and returning around 4:30 PM. A welcome dinner will be held on Friday night from 6:30 PM (buffet in Village dining room or BBQ at Camp Kitchen).
- Saturday 9 Mar 13. Rally registration will be open from 7:00 AM at the Camp Kitchen. Rider brief will be given at 9:00 AM outside Camp Kitchen. The Saturday ride will depart at 9:30 AM and take in regional NSW and ACT and generally be around 130 km. There will be a morning tea and lunch stop, with machine judging taking place at the Saturday lunch stop. The presentation dinner (table service) will be held in the Village dining hall 6:30 PM – 10:30 PM. The AGM will be held in the Village conference room at 4:30 PM.
- Sunday 10 Mar 13. Swap Meet 6:00 AM – 8:00 AM in Village (Assembly Point B). Riders brief will be given at 9:00 AM outside Camp Kitchen. The Sunday ride will depart at 9:30 AM through regional NSW and ACT and generally be around 160 km. There will be a morning tea and lunch stop.

**Note:** The Village dining room is BYO. Times listed for all events may change as circumstances dictate.

There is no ride scheduled for Monday because of the Park's commitment to schools (this is a problem throughout the region at this time because of the centenary anniversary of Canberra celebrations). However, a short follow-the-leader ride to a local point of interest can be arranged for those who do not need to depart the region on the Monday.

There are plenty of cabins, villas and bungalows accommodation, plus powered and grassed caravan sites available to rally entrants from Friday 8 Mar 13 to Monday 11 Mar 13 at the Capital Country Holiday Park. Because of commitments to schools, only the 7 Lake Villas and 5 Bungalows, plus powered caravan and camping sites are available other nights.
