

AUSTRALIAN ARIEL REGISTER – EVENT PERMIT SYSTEM

Any event held under the name of the Australian Ariel register that involves access to third party property (land or equipment) should have public liability insurance (PLI) cover. PLI may be obtained for such events by contacting the Secretary, who will arrange for an Event Permit to be provided by NSW Motorcycling Alliance or one of the other Motorcycling Alliance State bodies. As the A.A.R. is affiliated with NSW Motorcycling Alliance (NSWMA), permits would normally be applied for from NSWMA. However, the affiliation with NSWMA enables any other Motorcycling Alliance State body to approve an event permit. Once an event permit is issued by Motorcycling Alliance, the AAR has PLI cover from Motorcycling Australia's \$50M PLI. Cost for a permit is \$66 for the first day and \$33 for every subsequent day. If the event involves managing camping on public or private grounds it may be necessary to obtain PLI cover for camping (as per requests from property owners). PLI cover for camping costs \$120/day. Events that do not involve third parties, such as ordinary rides to a public locality and return, do not require PLI, thus do not need an event permit.
